b] Ananya who develops an online platform that customizes programming tutorials for different skill levels.

(iii) “No matter what decisions I take on my own, I will never be able to meet my family’s and society’s expectations. It is better that I just relax and let them make decisions for me.” Is this a Caged response or a Creator of Destiny response? **01**

- (vii) Martha works with local artisans and sells their handicrafts. What will make her a Contributor? **01**
- a] When she is able to build a sustainable customer base for the artisan community.
- b] When she is able to get the handicrafts from the artisans at the lowest possible price in order to sell them.
- (viii) Who is using an Entrepreneurial Career Pathway in work? **01**
- a] A fashion design graduate who wants to become the 'Fashion Designer of the Year'.
- b] A musician who wants to start a school where several musical instruments can be taught.
- (ix) A small shop owner's sales drop after a big supermarket opens nearby. How would he think if he had Creator thinking? **01**
- a] "I can offer unique items or better service, so customers prefer my shop."
- b] "I'll try to continue as long as I can make the shop survive."

- (x) A group of students are part of a start-up incubated by their college. They are invited to pitch their idea at a national startup competition. They think: *“This stage feels too big for us... - Q.3** (a) Imagine being rejected from your dream job. How would you deal with the rejection using 'I-CAN'? **03**
- What 'I-CAN' needs are required to move forward?
- (b) For the above situation, what 'I-CAN's do you already have? Why do you believe you have it? **04**

- (c) How would you expand your 'I-CAN' Zone to make yourself ready for the job search? Specify some concrete steps you can take to build the new I-CANs. **07**

- Q.3** (a) As an intern in a company, reflect on your ability to contribute. What does "Power to Contribute" mean to you in the context of an internship? Give one example of how you can expand this power. **03**

- (b) List three specific contributions you would like to make in your internship. For each, mention who will benefit and how. **04**

- (c) Choose two contributions from part 3B(b) and explain in detail what concrete steps can be taken that will help the company achieve their goals. Support your answer with explanations and/or examples. **07**

- Q.4** (a) Imagine yourself as a member of the student body/council for the intercollegiate festival. Who are your stakeholders? **03**

- (b) Select two stakeholders from the list identified in 4A(a). Give 2 contributions you can make for each selected stakeholder. Explain why you consider them as contributions for the specific stakeholders? **04**

- (c) What are some actions you will take to make any of these contributions? Specify the roots you plan to develop in your Tree of Sustainable Success. **07**

- Q.4** (a) Take up any experience in your life which you consider a success. Briefly describe the experience and explain why you consider it a success. List the different kinds of fruits that you got through it. **03**

- (b) Draw or describe the Tree of Sustainable Success for this experience. Clearly mention the fruits and roots developed through this experience. Explain how you developed these roots of success. **04**

- (c) From this experience, what are some other fruits and roots you could create? What could you have done differently to get these additional fruits/roots? **07**
- Q.5** (a) Your friend Ravi lives in a small town. He dreams of making his community environmentally sustainable, which is why he wants to become an environmental engineer. However, his family cannot afford the high costs of specialized courses and training. **03**
