Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering | 1995 – 2027

GATE is jointly conducted every year by the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bangalore and seven IITs (Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, and Roorkee) on behalf of the National Coordination Board – GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education. The organizing institute rotates each year among these eight institutes. The table below lists the organizing institute for every edition of GATE from 1995 to 2027.

Rotation Pattern

Each of the eight institutes hosts GATE roughly once every eight years, cycling through in the same order. Based on the years above, the standard rotation sequence (read top to bottom, repeating) is: IIT Madras → IIT Guwahati → IIT Roorkee → IISc Bangalore → IIT Kanpur → IIT Kharagpur → IIT Bombay → IIT Delhi → (back to IIT Madras).

Note: The source data lists IIT Madras as the organizing institute for GATE 2027, which is one step ahead of IIT Guwahati in the usual rotation shown above; readers should verify the exact GATE 2027 organizing institute against the official GATE website closer to the exam.
